GENERAL TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Tournament will be USBC certified. Any rules not listed here, will be governed by USBC rules. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his or her averages listed on the other side of this entry form. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is **DISQUALIFIED**. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average.
2. **HANDICAP.** All handicaps will be based on 90% of the difference between the team average and 460, up to a maximum of 134 pins per game. Any team entering with an average of 460 or over will bowl **SCRATCH**. Handicaps for any Special Singles Events will be based on 90% of the difference between the individual Bowler's average and 230, up to a maximum of 67 pins per game.
3. All averages must be from a USBC Certified league. Membership cards from the USBC must be presented at time of entry, excluding re-entries. A bowler without a USBC Membership card must purchase a USBC membership card to participate in this tournament. Unattached USBC membership cards may be purchased at the site at a cost of \$21.00, and the Bowler must use a 230 average.
4. Bowlers must use their highest 2008-2009 Winter season USBC certified average, based on a minimum of 21 or more games. Bowlers must use their 2009-2010 Winter season average if average is 10 pins or more than that of the highest 2008-2009 Winter season. The 2009-2010 Winter season average must have a minimum of 21 games by the date of June 1, 2010.
4a. Bowlers whose averages cannot be verified will be disqualified and individual and team prize monies will be forfeited. Summer League averages and YABA averages are not permitted for this tournament. All segments of USBC Rule 319 is in effect for this tournament. **USBC RULE 319E APPLIES TO ALL BOWLERS AVERAGING 230 OR LESS.**
5. **The average (Re-rating) of a Bowler may be adjusted upward before participation in any event. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded. A Bowler must Report any and all Average adjustment or re-rates prior to bowling or your scores WILL be disqualified. A Bowler must also notify tournament officials of any intended adjustment or re-rate (written or verbal) from any other tournament that the Bowler previously participated in, or your scores will be disqualified.**
6. **ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS FULLY COMPLETED.** No refund of fees submitted with entry blank once entry is received. Closing Date for entries will be August 8, 2010 at 6:00 P.M. Rules, entry fee and conditions under which entries are accepted cannot be changed or modified, after the tournament starts.
7. Bowlers must abide by all rules and any decision made by the Tournament Committee of this event, and said Committee shall have the right to reject the entry of any bowler or team. Tournament reserves the right to request a photo ID for identification purposes. Refusal or failure to provide upon request may result in disqualification.
8. **MULTIPLE ENTRIES ARE PERMITTED:** A bowler may bowl as many times as she/he wishes, but can **CASH ONLY ONCE** with the same partner. In the Singles Events, a Bowler, can **CASH ONLY ONCE** in the prize list for position standings.
8a. **WHILE BOWLING MIXED DOUBLES** – Each bowler can choose to bowl with up to 2 additional bowlers of the opposite gender in the same squad – for an additional entry fee of \$28.00 per team. *EXAMPLE: (Robert & Julie enter a squad at the regular entry fee of \$50.00. Robert may then bowl with Jane, who is bowling in the same squad, and pay an additional \$28.00 per team. Robert may also bowl with Mary, in that same squad, and pay an additional \$28.00 for the additional team. The total additional cost to bowl with Jane and Mary will be \$56.00).*
8b. **WHILE BOWLING IN ANY DOUBLES EVENT** – There will be no bowling with additional bowlers across the different events. *EXAMPLE: (When bowling in the Men's or Women's Doubles, you can bowl with up to 2 additional bowlers of the same gender only in that respective event).*
9. Each team will bowl three consecutive games across three pairs of lanes. The three games total pin count, including handicap will be the final score. A bowler may participate in Singles while bowling doubles. A **MINIMUM OF TWO TEAMS**, and not more than four teams are required to bowl on the same pair of lanes.
10. To qualify for the Special Seniors Singles Handicap Event, a Bowler must be age 55 or over. To enter the Senior Singles – an additional \$5.00 per entry is required along with a regular entry fee.
11. If an automatic pinsetter or scorer has a breakdown, the tournament management reserves the right to move the bowlers to other lanes. Premature termination of the tournament brought by war, national emergency, or emergency caused relating there to or there from fire, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other reasons beyond the control of the tournament committee shall cause the foregoing prize schedules to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of termination.
12. All Prize fees collected will be distributed 100 percent to participants of this tournament. There will be at least one prize for each ten entries or major fraction thereof. Prizes will be awarded within 4 weeks after the close of the tournament.
13. Bowlers should arrive at least 1 hour early, before squad time to enter a scheduled squad. If bowlers are already entered for a scheduled squad time, then each bowler must check in 30 minutes before squad time.
14. Any current members, or former members during the past three calendar years, of the PBA or any other professional bowling organization, are ineligible to participate in this tournament.
