Tournament Rules

General Information:

This tournament will take place on Saturday August 14th, 2010 at 1:00 p.m. It will be held at Jersey Lanes: 30 North Park Ave., Linden, NJ 07036.

Eligibility:

This tournament is open to all male and female junior bowlers 19 years of age or less as of August 1st, 2010 who have never bowled in competition where cash is offered as a prize. The United States Bowling Congress (USBC) will sanction the tournament. Bowlers who are not certified through USBC or a USBC league are not permitted to bowl.

Format:

Scratch Division-Athletes will bowl 4 games across 8 lanes in the qualifying round. At the completion of the qualifying round the top 16 bowlers will advance to the PBA bracket-style match play. The scores from the 4 games of qualifying will determine the seed of the bowler for the match play portion of the tournament. Bowlers will be seeded in the following style: 1 vs. 16, 2 vs. 15, 3 vs. 14 and so on. Each round of match play will consist of 2 game matches with total pin fall determining who advances to the next round. The bracket will continue until there are two bowlers left, with the higher scorer being declared the champion.

Handicapped Division-Bowlers will follow the same format as the scratch division (above). In addition to this, 100% of the difference between the bowler's average and 200 will be added to each game in the qualifying round and in the match play round.

Averages- will be determined in the following order:

A: Bowlers are to submit their highest 2009-2010 USBC Sanctioned Final League Average (minimum 45 games).

B: If a bowler cannot fulfill the first requirement, they are to use their highest 2008-2009 USBC Sanctioned Final League Average (minimum 45 games).

C: All others without an average will use 200.

Note: Summer league averages are NOT accepted. Also, ALL handicap division tournament entries must be accompanied by proof of average in the form of a final league standing sheet. If the bowler does not conform to the above average rules and/or attempts to falsify their average, or provide an incorrect average lower than that of their actual average, they will be disqualified.

Ties- In case of a tie for 16th place after the qualifying round or a tie at the end of a match play round, a 9th and 10th frame roll off will determine bowler who advances to the next round. If two bowlers within the top 16 spots bowl the same four game score for the qualifying round, the bowler with the higher single game score will get the higher seed.

Re-Racks- Bowlers are allowed two re-racks per game. Additional re-racks may be granted as determined by the tournament director only.

Entry Fee:

The entry fee for bowlers will be \$30.00 per person prior to August 1st. After August 1st the entry fee will be \$35.00 per person with the extra \$5.00 being added into the Scholarship fund. Breakdown of the entry fee is as follows:

\$12.00 for Lineage, \$15.00 for Prize Fund, \$3.00 for expenses.

All checks MUST be payable to: JERSEY LANES. **NO** checks will be accepted after August 1st, 2010. There will be a charge for a returned check. Once an entry fee has been processed there will be no refunds.

Scholarships

The prize fund is based on 32 entries in each division and will be returned 100%. All scholarship money will be deposited promptly into a SMART account within 30 days of the completion of the tournament.

Attire/Conduct:

Proper dress and behavior is expected of all participants. Collared shirts are strongly encouraged. Bowlers are not permitted to wear hats, headsets, sleeveless shirts, and clothing with offensive language or graphics. Bowlers who use foul language, make obscene gestures, or abuse equipment will be subject to disqualification, as determined by the tournament director. Bowlers who switch hands any time during the tournament will be automatically disqualified. Participants are not permitted to smoke before, during, or after the tournament, inside or outside the building. Only the bowlers still in competition, assigned scorekeepers, and tournament officials will be permitted in the settee area.

Check In:

All participants must be ready to check in by 12:30 p.m. or their spot in the tournament may be given to a bowler on the waiting list. Entries will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Walk-in entries will be accepted at the tournament site as space permits. Any bowler who arrives after the start time of the tournament will receive no practice and will begin in the current frame in progress and receive a zero score for all frames not bowled up to that point.

Other:

All rules not specifically covered will be governed by the rules of the United States Bowling Congress. The tournament director reserves all rights regarding all rules and the operation of the tournament.
